

ADMISSION

Admission will be made strictly on basis of merit.

The birth certificate from a competent authority and the transfer certificate obtained from the previous school are essential at the time of admission.

Admission has to be taken within seven days of selection failing which the seat will be allotted to the next awaited candidate.

TEST / INTERVIEW

Admission is taken on the basis of written and oral test subject to availability of seats in a particular class. For admission in different classes, tests are conducted according to standard of the previous class passed. Selected candidates in the written test and interview are called for admission. There is no specific syllabus for admission test but a candidate must have sufficient knowledge for the class lower than that in which he/she desires admission.

REGISTRATION

Prospectus and Registration forms for admission are available at school office counter. It should be dully filled up and submitted with the required documents and certificates as mentioned in the form within stipulated period. Registration fee is non-refundable.

ASSEMBLY

The school starts with morning assembly which includes recitation of prayer, Pledge,

National Anthem, Thought for the day and the News headlines.

HOUSE SYSTEM

To create an atmosphere of healthy competition and team spirit, the students are divided into four houses namely ASIA, EVEREST, NILE & PACIFIC. Most of the school activities are governed by House System. Inter House competitions are organised under the House Flags.

EDUCATIONAL TOUR

The School plans picnics and educational tours for the students. They are taken to Historical Places, Museums, Factories, Research Institutions etc. to give them a first hand knowledge.

EXHIBITION

Art & Craft Exhibition, Science Exhibition and Painting competitions are also held.

EXAMINATION AND PROGRESS REPORT

Parents are informed regularly of their ward's academic progress and participation in various exams. Besides these, revision tests are also conducted periodically. Promotion is granted on the basis of performance in the Final Exams.

ATTENDANCE

75% attendance is essential for promotion to the next higher class.

In case of sickness, a medical certificate from a registered medical practitioner has to be submitted along with an application.

Repeated absence without leave or unexplained absence for more than one month renders a student liable to have his/her name struck off the rolls.

Re-admission may be granted only on payment of fresh admission charge at the discretion of Principal.

GUIDELINES FOR STUDENTS

- All the students must possess school diary, text-books, exercise books, stationery etc.
- Application for leave must be submitted one day in advance duly signed by parents.
- Students are advised not to bring valuable articles to the school. The school will not be responsible for any such loss.
- Students must come in proper school uniform.
- They must be clean, neat and tidy. School identity card must be with the students.
- Any damage to the school property by the students will have to be borne by the student's parents/guardians. Students are not allowed to leave the school during school hours except on medical ground.

RECOMMENDATION TO THE PARENTS

Parents are required to co-operate with the school in it's attempt to help their child's progress by paying attention to their regularity, punctuality and discipline and by taking interest in their ward's academic activities.





Guidelines for Guardians

- Ensure that your ward comes to school in proper uniform with polished shoes, trimmed hair and nails.
- No student should be sent to school if suffering from a contagious or infectious disease.
- Use the school diary as a means of communication with the class teacher and school and check the diary for Home Work and the teacher's remarks, if any.
- Sign the test copies as and when sent home.
- Pay the fee as per schedule.
- The Parents (both mother and father) must attend the Parent-Teacher Meet.
- Intimate the school in case of change in address, telephone number etc.
- Ensure that all the books and exercise books, are covered with brown paper.
- Ensure that your ward brings books and exercise books as per the time-table.
- Don't walk into the class room or meet any teacher without prior permission of the Principal.
- Don't send money or valuable articles with the students. The school takes no responsibility if it is lost.
- Ensure that your ward doesn't bring non-veg/fast food in lunch box.

PERSONAL-FILE

The school maintains an individual file of all its students to have a systematic record for the academics as well as cocurricular progress and achievements.

RESIDUARY

The School Management reserves the right to alter/amend any of the rules in the prospectus at any time at its own discretion which will be

binding on parents.

- In addition to the foregoing, parents and students are presumed to have read and accepted the contents of this prospectus as the rules of the school.
- Date of Examinations and vacations are subject to change as per school's convenience considering the interest of the student and the school.

COUNSELING OF PARENTS

In order to establish a meaningful relationship between the school and the parents, counseling is conducted periodically to discuss the progress of the students.
